**MAYORAL PROCLAMATION  
OF MANDATORY CURFEW  
DURING STATE OF EMERGENCY  
(AMENDED)**

**WHEREAS,** on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of August, 2008, I proclaimed a curfew for all citizens other than first responders, emergency and relief workers within the City of New Orleans and the Parish of Orleans from eight o'clock p.m. (8:00 p.m.) until six o'clock a.m. (6:00 a.m.) each and every night until the Proclamation is rescinded or amended;

**WHEREAS,** on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2008, I amended that curfew in recognition of the fact that power had returned in some areas of the City, but not others, and that many areas of the City remained unlit and sparsely populated;

**WHEREAS,** the City of New Orleans and Parish of Orleans remains under a State of Emergency;


**WHEREAS,** substantial improvements have been and continue to be made to the infrastructure of the City and Parish permitting more citizens and business owners to return;

**WHEREAS,** most areas of the City are well populated, with residents and tourists;

**NOW THEREFORE,** I, C. Ray Nagin, as Mayor and Chief Executive Officer of the City of New Orleans and the Parish of Orleans, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of Louisiana and the Home Rule Charter, City Code, and laws of the City of New Orleans, do hereby order and proclaim that the curfew declared by me on August 31, 2008, and amended on September 5, 2008 is hereby rescinded, effective immediately.

The City Attorney is directed to file this Proclamation promptly in the Office of the Clerk of Court, and with the Office of Emergency Preparedness as soon as is reasonably possible under the circumstances.

IN WITNESS wherefore I have fixed my hand hereto this 8<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2008.
